THE HIRING PROCESS; Physical Ability Test, Orientation Session, Written Examination, Oral Interviews, Polygraph Examination, Psychological Evaluation, Credit Check, Background Investigation, Medical Examination

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

AGE: Under the age of 35 years, and a minimum age of 21 at time of application. A 20 year old may apply if the person has completed two years of law enforcement studies at an accredited college or university.

VISION: Correctable to 20/40, with normal peripheral vision and free from color blindness.

RESIDENCY: Must reside within the State of Illinois at offer of appointment.

EDUCATION: 60 semester hours of college credit earned (or the equivalent of 60 semester hours in trimester or quarter hours) at the time of application.

DRIVERS LICENSE: Valid Driver's License and where applicable, an Illinois drivers' license at offer of appointment.

OTHER: Ability to pass all selection, training, and hiring requirements as described in the application packet.

CITIZENSHIP: U.S. Citizen. Elector of United States.

Physical Ability Testing (P.O.W.E.R. test): P.O.W.E.R. tests are conducted by the Northeastern Illinois Public Safety Training Academy (NIPSTA) and must be **completed before August 15, 2009**. To register and for information on the requirements of the P.O.W.E.R. test, test dates and fees, contact NIPSTA at www.nipsta.org or 847-998-8090. A valid P.O.W.E.R. test card must be presented to gain entry to the orientation and written exam.

- **Orientation Session and Written Exam – August 15, 2009:** will be conducted jointly with the Winnetka Police Department on Saturday, August 15, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. at New Trier West High School, 7 Happ Road, Northfield, IL. Attendance at the orientation is mandatory and the written examination will be held following the orientation session.
