Dear Northfielders,

Now that Governor Pritzker has advanced Illinois to Phase 3 of his Restore Illinois plan, we are seeing the modified reopening of some of our restaurants and retail stores. If you choose to patronize these establishments, check their website or give them a call to find out what safety measures they are employing. The State of Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity has announced guidelines with specific procedures businesses must follow if they choose to open. Consistent with these guidelines, some businesses ask that you remain in your car until you are asked to come in to their stores. Some require that you wear a face mask inside their establishments. Because the particulars depend upon the type of business at issue, you should check before going.

The following chart lists some of the Northfield businesses that are now open or at least open in limited fashion. Because this list changes on a daily basis, it is necessarily incomplete. Therefore, if you are waiting to visit a specific business that is not listed here, check the business's website or phone them to find out their status.

Food Vendor Operations

Food establishments can provide food for delivery, drive-through, carry out, and curb-side pick-up. Those that have outdoor seating can provide outdoor dining.

Liquor License holders can offer carry-out or curb-side pickup of packaged liquor. Alcohol must be in the original sealed packaging and otherwise sold in compliance with all other applicable federal, state, and local laws.

Please Do Not Return Materials Yet! Our Returns Remain Closed.

Accepting returns is the next phase of our reopening. Unlike restaurants or retail stores which offer consumables, the Library's materials circulate out to patrons' homes, back to the library, and out again. Because of that, all materials upon their return will need to be handled by staff wearing the appropriate safety equipment and then quarantined for a period of three to seven days before those materials can be checked out to another individual. It is imperative that we have systems, equipment, and supplies in place so that we can comfortably minimize the risks to the people handling those materials and for those



receiving them. While we work out the details, please keep your items at home. Stay tuned for the announcement when we are able to begin accepting returns! And remember that there will be no fines for any materials you have checked out during the building closure.

Local Hero

Northfielder Neil Cases is an ICU nurse at the University of Illinois Hospital, where he works long hours caring for COVID-19 patients. Due to his work environment, he necessarily bears the risk of carrying the virus on his person when he returns home from the hospital. When Cases first started working in pandemic conditions, he slept in a tent to protect his family from infection. After three nights outdoors, Neil and his wife Olivia reached out to a program called RVs 4 MDs. Courtesy of this program, a family from Highland Park loaned their RV to Neil so that he can have a comfortable place to isolate after work. Now Neil gets a home-cooked meal each night, and more importantly he sleeps well, knowing that he is keeping his family safe.
